### **DLA Piper secures victory for the Republic of Guinea in multi-billion euro dispute with BSGR**

DLA Piper has obtained a significant win for the Republic of Guinea in its multi-billion euro investment arbitration against BSGR. The

arbitration concerned development rights over the world's largest iron deposit, Simandou.
