Every year since their inception, World Bank Group (the Bank) sanctions teams have pursued investigations into alleged sanctionable conduct regarding the Bank’s projects in Africa. There have been both uncontested sanctions imposed by the Bank Suspension and Debarment Officer (SDO) and cases unsuccessfully appealed to the Sanctions Board throughout Africa every year since 2011. The proportion of all global allegations and investigations taking place in Africa is typically higher than most other regions.
